


THE GOLDEN YEAR OF 2010

March sent us down the hill, on a bus to El Segundo to visit the **Automobile Driving Museum**.






On April 25th, we spent a beautiful warm day at Nottinghams. The lake view was a welcomed sight after all of the snow!
